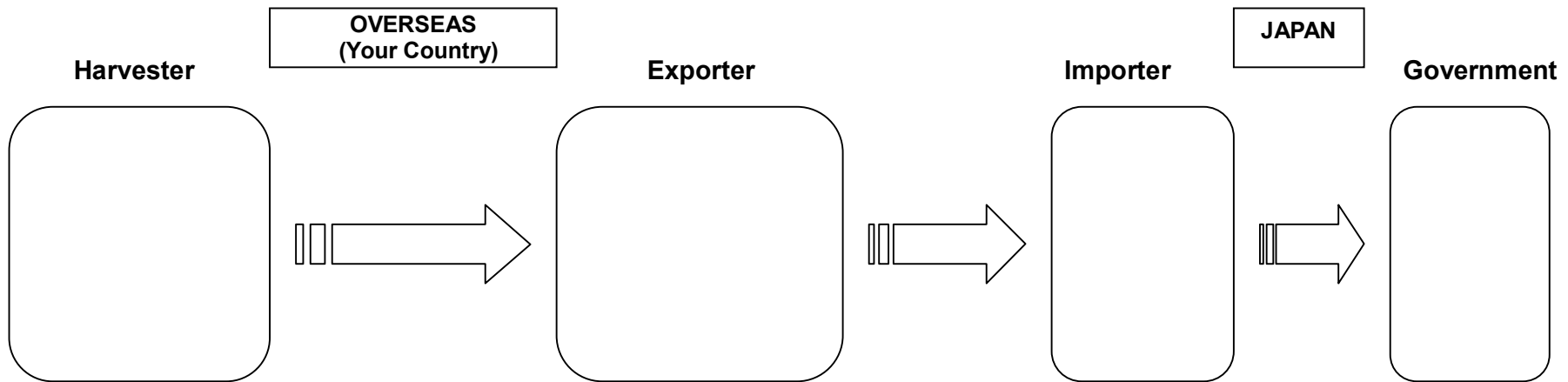


Documents Required for Verification on Legality and Sustainability of Wood and Wood Products *-Example Illustrated for Company Overseas-*



Timber harvested in legal and sustainable manner

Proper Chain of Custody separated from illegal timber

Verification (Example ※)
 1. Forest Certification (SGEC, FSC, SFI, CSA, PEFC etc.)
 2. Documents issued by authorities concerned on legality and sustainability of wood and wood products (Permission on harvesting, exporting, etc.)
 3. Other documents with the same level of reliability as 1 or 2 above.

◎ Importers in Japan are primarily responsible for the verification in this public procurement policy.

Notes
 → : Flow of Wood and Wood Products
 And intermediate industries such as processing, distributing, marketing on both sides are omitted for simplification and clear understanding on what kinds of documents may requested at exporting phase.

- ※ It will vary as legal system and commercial customs in each country differs.
- ※ And additional papers and documents might be requested if existence of illegal logging is undoubtedly sure with considerable evidence.
