- Member: 41 NGOs & 259 individual



Role

- NGO and indigenous people stated as Independent Monitoring (IM/IFM)
- → IM/IFM recognize by the rule: include in the system
- → IM/IFM is the key to ensure credibility of SVLK
- ♦ IM/IFM monitor:
 - Accreditation process
 - Audit process
 - Regulation implementation
